



INSTRUCTIONS TO CREATE AN ACCOUNT ON SCIFINDER-N CHEMICAL ABSTRACTS

Sept. 2025 update

Strictly reserved for members of UGA and Grenoble INP

Scifinder-n, software that allows users to search Chemical Abstracts, only requires a web browser (Firefox is recommended).

However, the system requires the creation of a **personal account** with a login and password. It can be created by the following authorized users: all students, teaching and research staff, as well as administrative and library staff at UGA and Grenoble INP.

Under no circumstances should the login and password for accessing the database be disclosed to a third party.

Simultaneous access is unlimited for the entire institution.

Creating an account on SciFinder-n implies acceptance of the **following conditions:**

- Not sharing your login and password with third parties
- Conducting searches solely for your own use and under no circumstances for another institution
- Not using programs or scripts to extract or download CAS data
- You may store a maximum of 5,000 records for personal use or for use in a project, for the duration of the project only.

- The license agreement between our institution and CAS applies to personal use of the database (see license information at: <http://www.cas.org/legal/infopolicy>)
- Contact the Chemical Abstracts representative (see contact details at the end of this document) and not CAS directly if a problem arises.

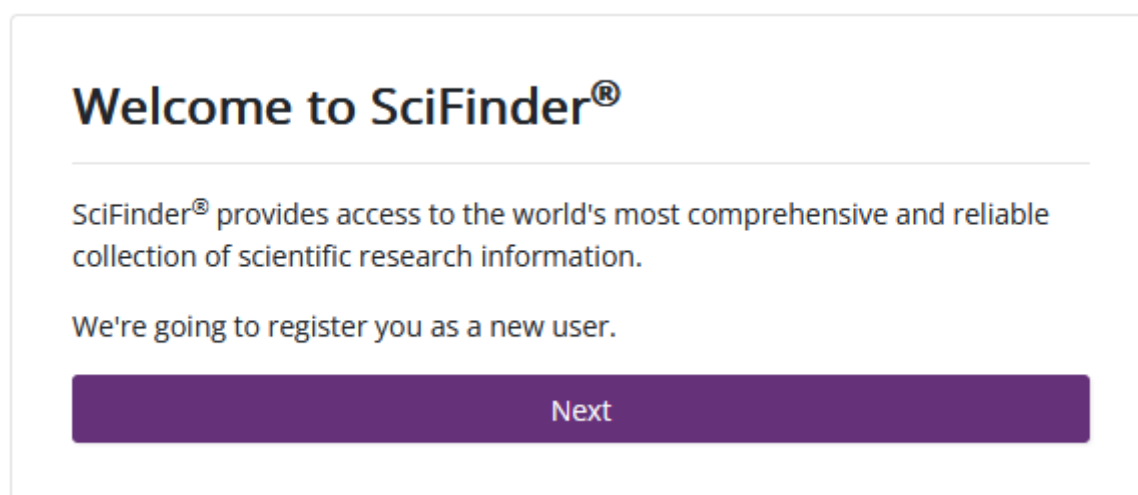
With that clarified, here is how to create your account and log in:

Copy-paste the following link in your web browser:

After going through the Welcome to SciFinder page (click NEXT)



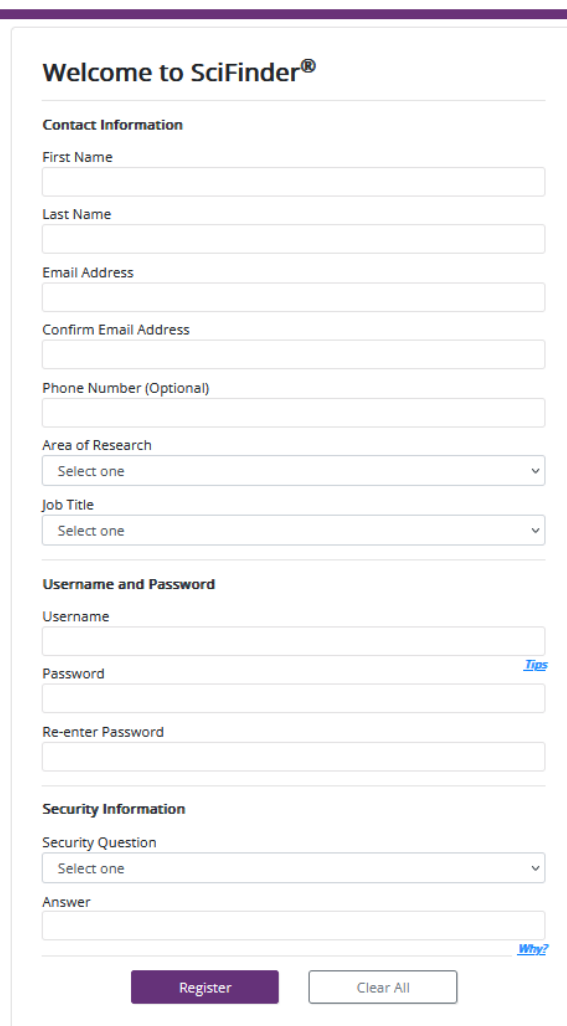
After accepting the License Agreement, you will be taken to:

Fill in all fields.

Please note! The email address must be an institutional address, i.e., it must end with univ-grenoble-alpes.fr or grenoble-inp.fr.

Click on Register.

Shortly after registering, you will receive an email containing a URL at the email address you provided. You must click on the link provided to finalize the validation of your account.

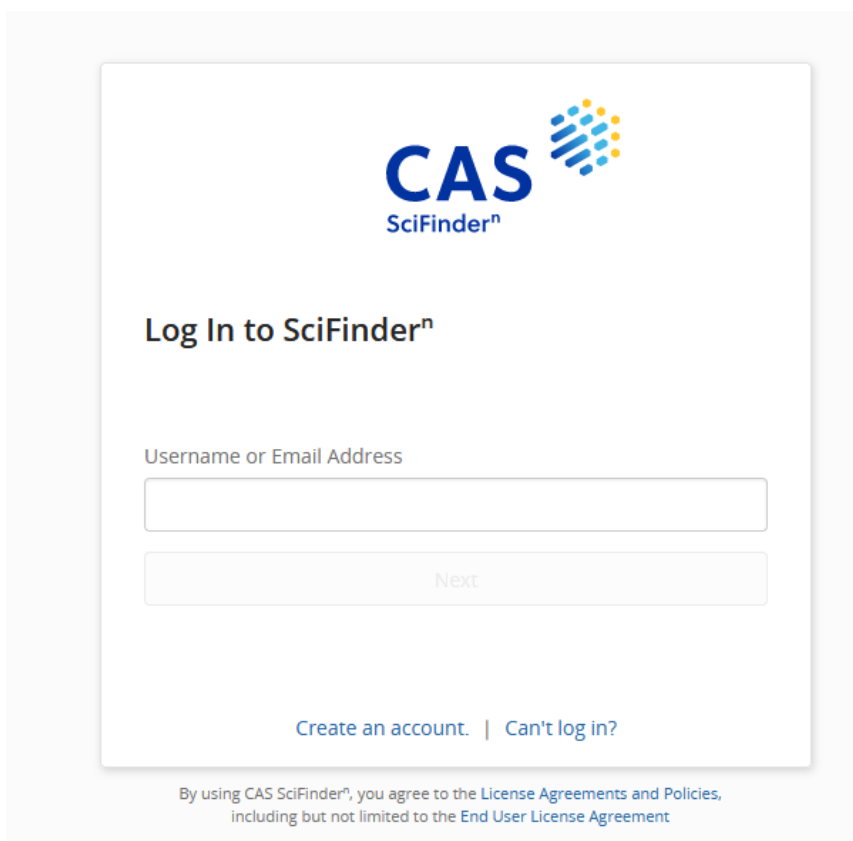
To log in, you **MUST** use one of these two methods:
